

American United Federal Credit Union Notice to Consumer of State Privacy Protections

Effective Date: January 1, 2020

American United collects information that identifies, relates to, describes, references, is capable of being associated with, or could reasonably be linked, directly or indirectly, with a particular consumer or device ("**personal information**")

Most of the information that American United collects is subject to the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act ("GLBA"), the Fair Credit Reporting Act ("FCRA"), and regulations promulgated by the National Credit Union Administration ("NCUA") and the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau ("CFPB"). Thus, a vast majority of the information we collect may not be subject to the protections provided under state law.

If your state does not have specific laws, you may request details about the information we have collected specific to you through any of the methods listed in the Contact Information section below. In most cases, if we can verify who you are, we will provide you with a copy of your information upon request.
