



SCHOLARSHIP AWARD PROGRAM

American United Federal Credit Union and the American United Charitable Foundation are pleased to offer several scholarship opportunities. Our scholarships are offered to credit union members who have overcome hardships or unique circumstances in order to pursue their secondary education. These scholarships are intended for individuals attending or desiring to attend an accredited secondary college/university, vocational, or technical school.

Eligibility

To qualify, applicants must

- a) Be admitted to or attending an accredited secondary college/university, vocational, or technical school.
- b) Be member of American United Federal Credit Union
- c) Be overcoming financial hardship or unique circumstances in order to pursue their secondary education.
- d) Not be a current employee of American United Federal Credit Union.

Scholarships

In 2023, up to \$10,000 in scholarships will be awarded.

Procedures

- a) Complete the Scholarship Application via the enclosed document or at www.amucu.org/scholarship
- b) Write an essay (300 words or less) that focuses on why you feel you are deserving of this scholarship, your field of study, and long-term education/career goals.
- c) Provide an official admittance letter or transcript from an accredited secondary college/university, vocational or technical school.
- d) After the deadline, applications that have met all requirements will be sent to the Scholarship Committee for a blind selection process. Once the winner has been selected, they will be notified.

Only those applicants who have submitted all required items by the date listed will be considered by the Scholarship Committee.

Deadline

Application and supporting materials must be postmarked no later than **July 15, 2023**.
